


Key of Accumulator-charging Trial Technology (K.A.T.T.)



System of K.A.T.T.





Students use different kinds of light bulbs


60% uses simple light bulbs

33% uses energy saving light bulbs

7% uses halogen light bulbs

Saving energy when computers are not in use

- 64% of students switches them off
- 16% of students leaves them in sleep mode
- 20% of students just leaves them on
- Sleep mode can save 0,04 KWh an hour, 70 KWh a year





- Drinking and cooking:1-5 litres/person/day
 - Having a bath: 75-200 litres/occasion
 - Having a shower:50-100 litres/occasion
 - Washing clothes:40-100 litres/occasion
- Washing the dishes with dishwasher:12-20litres/occasion
 - Washing the dishes by hand:40 litres/occasion
 - Washout of the toilet:11-26 litres/occasion
 - Leaking tap:40-120 litres/day
